

SUPER HERO COMIC CONTEST ENTRY & PERMISSION FORM

From June 1 through July 15, 2020 (the "Contest Period"), the West Virginia Immunization Network ("WIN"), a program of The Center for Rural Health Development, Inc. ("The Center") will conduct an comic book and graphic novel contest open only to 5th to 12th grade students in West Virginia. To enter the contest, students must create their own comic strip or short graphic novel (4 pages maximum) about a "superhero(es)" that develops a vaccine and saves lives. The comic strip or graphic novel should tell the story of either a historic "superhero" who has developed a vaccine; or a future everyday "superhero" that creates a vaccine to prevent COVID-19. The contest will be administered through the WIN Steering Committee.

To enter, eligible students must submit an comic book or brief graphic novel entry that follows these contest submission guidelines. Only one entry per student is permitted. Entries that are incomplete, submitted late, or otherwise do not comply with these rules will not be accepted or considered. Contest submissions must be original and have been created by the student entrant with minimal parent/legal guardian assistance; the submission must not have been published previously; the submission must not contain any material that violates or infringes upon the rights of any third party, including without limitation any copyright, trademark or rights of privacy or publicity, or that is defamatory, unlawful or in violation of or contrary to any applicable law or regulation; and the

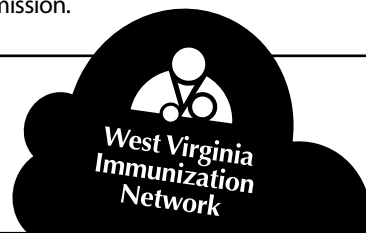
submission must not contain any material that The Center, in its sole discretion, deems inappropriate for public viewing.

By entering the contest, entrants agree that The Center will own all entries submitted with the perpetual right to use such entries. The Center may modify entries for style only and distribute the submitted entries with no additional notification or permission of the entrant.

To enter the contest, the contestant must:

- ✓ Be a resident of West Virginia;
- ✓ Be a student in grades 5-12 (for the 2020-2021 school year);
- ✓ Submit an original comic strip or short graphic novel about a historic or future "superhero" that develops a vaccine to prevent disease by the contest **deadline of July 15, 2020 at 11:59 pm;**
- ✓ Complete the entry form (below) AND have a parent/guardian complete the included permission form; and
 - ✉ If the contest entry is mailed, include the completed entry form/permission slip with the contest submission.
 - @ If the contest entry is submitted by email, include the completed entry form/permission slip in the same email containing the contest submission.

Please complete this form and submit with the contest entry. Incomplete forms or forms that are not legible will not be accepted and the accompanying comic strip or graphic novel will not be considered in the contest.
